

B.O.M. Agreed Report

- The BOM is to seek a written report on the progress of the planning application for the Old School Car Park.
- The BOM approved a new Child Safeguarding Statement.
- Training for BOM members in relation to the boards changing roles and responsibilities for the new Child First legislation is to take place on Monday 23rd of April at 7pm.
- Approval was given for a school closure to allow staff training to take place so that staff can familiarise themselves with the new Child Safeguarding guidelines and arrangements.
- The BOM had a successful meeting with the PA in relation to fundraising going forward and improvements to the school grounds.
- Christina O Shea has been appointed to the AP2 post.
- Ailbhe Keogan is to visit the school for World Book Day to run a story writing workshop.
- Drumming Workshop is to take place on the 16th of April.
- 70% of the Emergency Works grant has been paid for the works carried out on the heating system.
- For extra-curricular bus journeys the school is to look for each child to voluntarily contribute €2 to the cost of the bus journey. This is to alleviate the cost of the journey to the schools. With the PA to also contribute to the cost.
