- No tenders for the construction of the SEN room and treatment plant have been received. Additional tenders are to be sought by BOM'S consultant.
- Planning for the Old School car park was submitted to Kerry Co Council. The planning department wrote back and are seeking more information before the application can be processed. This information is to be provided by the school's consultant.
- The increase in the voluntary contribution was agreed due to the increased cost of insurance and the deficit in the cost of the book rental scheme. It was also noted that the Auhacasla contribution was still below the cost of other schools in the locality. If parents wished to pay the 50 euro in instalments they may do so.
