Hope you are all keeping well. I got some excellent projects sent to me on WW2 along with great art construction on the Anderson Shelters. Very impressive and well done to all!!

So for week in Irish I would like the children to read 'Cleachtadh a dhéanann máistreacht' from 'Abair Liom' and the above exercises. 'Cleachtadh a dhéanann máistreacht' is a proverb meaning 'Practice makes perfect'. Abair Liom can be accessed on www.folensonline.ie but I can also send on a word document if anyone has any problems accessing it.

*The last three spellings chugainn, chugaibh agus chucu depend on the context for meaning. For example 'chugainn' = An tseachtain seo chugainn (next week) Tháinig an madra chugainn (The dog came to us)

For English I want you to have a look at Haiku poetry which is quite similar to the Tanka poetry from last week. I've uploaded a sheet of dingbats that the children can solve on Tuesday. The answers are included but try to refrain from giving the answers until they're happy with their guesses. Continue on with 'Read at Home' Wednesday and Thursday.

This week's Math is on Data and the different graphs that data can be presented. I have attached a powerpoint on the different graphs and the worksheets are based on the different graphs.

In Art, I would love if the children could create and design their own mandalas using the nature around them. I came across the artist Andy Goldsworthy lately and I think the children would enjoy making their own in the outdoors.
