This week in Irish continue on reading Léigh sa Bhaile Week 26 and answer the questions in your copy. You can write your spellings in Litriú agus Frásaí.

For English the theme is World War 2 and I've a different activity per night based on it.

In maths, we'll look at number theory as you seem to be getting on fine with the circle. The focus is on prime and composite numbers and I have made a short powerpoint explaining those numbers. I have attached two worksheets for you to complete.

I've also attached a template for a spitfire glider that you fold if you'd like to print it out.

How will you present your findings/project? Again completely up to you, some ideas might be a powerpoint, a video, a voice recording or podcast, a poster or a booklet with facts and pictures...you decide.

Bring art into your project by making something like an air raid shelter or a painting, again if you have focused in on something else maybe you'll decide to base your art on that, either way I've links below if you're looking for an idea.
