Tricky (Sight) words: Attached is a board game based on Junior Infants sight (tricky) words. Roll a dice, count on that number of spaces and say the word you land on. First to finish is the winner  $\odot$  this should help to revise words previously covered.

Gaeilge: 'An Aimsir' (the weather); this week we will revise some phrases we had learnt earlier on in the year... 'Cén saghas lá é?' (What kind of day is it?), 'Tá sé fuar' (It is cold).

Aistear: Our story this week is 'The Gruffalo'. #### Monday 11/5/20:

Jolly Phonics copy: Double sound 'ou': 'Jolly Phonics' copy. This double sound can also be written as 'ow', as in cow. Do some rainbow writing, draw some 'ou' words, for example; cloud, house, mouse...

Action for this double sound: Children pretend their finger is a needle and stab their thumb on the other hand saying 'ow'.

English Reading: Core Reader 2, 'The Duck Pond', p.21. Please note the 'sh' sound in fish and splash!

Gaeilge: 'Tá sé fuar' (It is cold).
