Dear Parents.

I hope you are all keeping safe and well. This document outlines the children's work for the coming week. As always, the outlined work remains optional. Here are some general notes on the work I have selected. Following this will be a daily guideline as to how the work can be approached.

Tricky (Sight) words: Attached is a board game(coloured) based on Senior Infants sight (tricky) words. Roll a dice, count on that number of spaces and say the word you land on. First to finish is the winner © this should help to revise words previously covered.

Gaeilge: 'An Aimsir' (the weather); this week we will revise some phrases we had learnt earlier on in the year... 'Cén saghas lá é?' (What kind of day is it?), 'Tá sé fuar' (It is cold).

Aistear: Our story this week is 'The Gruffalo'. Here is the YouTube link in order to listen to the story being read aloud: https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=s8sUPpPc8Ws. As always please listen to this story a few times and ask questions where possible throughout.

English Reading: I have included the tricky (sight) words with double sounds on the various pages. Please encourage the children to pick out these words while they are reading.
