

Senior Infant's Work 18/5/'20 - 22/5/'20

Dear Parents,

I hope you are all keeping safe and well. This document outlines the children's work for the coming week. As always, the outlined work remains optional. Here are some general notes on the work I have selected. Following this will be a daily guideline as to how the work can be approached.

Spelling Test: Here are the words for this week: from, oil, bunch, boil, coin, loud, owl

Gaeilge: This week we will revise words to do with the house, for example: teach (house), díon (roof), doras (door), fuinneog (window), simléar (chimney).

Tricky (sight) words: Keep revising these words. Use last week's board game or the laminated sheet in the children's folder. It is important that children can recognise these words quickly as they make up a large percentage of any book that they will pick up!

Monday 18/5/'20:

English Reading: Core Reader 4, 'A Ride at the Funfair', p.31.

Double Sounds: funfair, cool, ride (magic e), take (we say the 'e' is magic and it makes the 'a' in take long!)

Tricky Words: which, the, we

Skills Book: p.56

Maths: 'Busy at Maths', p.104 (attached)

Gaeilge: 'Féach ar an teach' (Look at the house)

Tuesday 19/5/'20:

English Reading: Core Reader 4, 'A ride at the Funfair', p.32 & 33.

Double Sounds: wait, round

Tricky Words: here, is, the, people, to, this, is, where, one

Go with the Flow B: p.17

Maths: 'Busy at Maths', p.105 (attached).

Gaeilge: 'Féach ar an doras' (Look at the door) 'Dún an doras' (Close the door)

Wednesday 20/5/'20:

English Reading: Core Reader 4, 'A ride at the Funfair', p.35

Double Sounds: horse

Tricky Words: when, the, you

Skills Book: p.57

Maths: 'Busy at Maths', p.106 (attached)

Gaeilge: 'Féach ar an bhfuinneog' (Look at the window) 'Oscail an doras' (Open the door)

Thursday 21/5/'20:

English Reading: Core Reader 4, 'A Ride at the Funfair', p.35

Tricky Words: you, this, be

Just Phonics: p. 68 & 69. Double sound 'ue' (long u)

Maths: 'Busy at Maths', p.107 (attached).

Gaeilge: 'Féach ar an díon' (Look at the roof).

Grow in Love: p. 44 & 45. The church is a special place where people go to pray. There are lots of symbols in the church that help us to think about God & Jesus; the altar, the crucifix and stained glass windows.

Friday 22/5/'20:

Gaeilge: 'Féach ar an simléar' (Look at the chimney)

Spelling Test

SESE: Summer

'What season is it?'

What are the months of the summer?

'What happens in the summer?' (weather is warm, longer days, trees full of green leaves, flowers blooming, bees collect nectar from flowers to make honey, caterpillars turn into beautiful butterflies?)

Please try and find signs of summer (see sheet attached)
