

Senior Infant's Work 5/5/'20 - 8/5/'20

Dear Parents,

I hope you are all keeping safe and well. This document outlines the children's work for the coming week. As always, the outlined work remains optional. Here are some general notes on the work I have selected. Following this will be a daily guideline as to how the work can be approached.

Spelling Test:

Here are the words for this week: film, then Gran, bang, cloth, gulp, sting.

Maths:

Senior Infants are beginning money this week. Exposing your child to real coins is the best way to teach this concept. However if you don't happen to have coins (1c and 2c coins are hard to come by now), I have attached two pages with coins which could be printed and cut out. There is also another page attached with price tags and children could try and figure out the coins needed to pay for the various items. This activity could be done over two days. I have referred to it as 'Going Shopping' on Monday and Tuesday's work. No item should cost more than 10c.

Gaeilge:

This week I am adding some more sentences to revise. You could play Simon Says, or 'Deir Ó Grádaigh' as I explained last week.

Outdoor Maths Trail:

Attached is a worksheet with pictures of things the children might look for outside, weather permitting! This particular trail focuses mainly on counting, so if possible ask the children to count out what they have found for each section. You also might like to ask questions such as 'If you added two more leaves how many altogether?'
