Phonics: Our new letter this week is 'x' and 'qu'.

- Always begin by revising the other letters, 'satpin' etc. You can do this by showing your child the letters in the zipped bag and getting them to say the <u>sound</u> and <u>not</u> the letter name.
- 2. Go to YouTube and insert 'Jolly Phonics letter x' and you will hear the sound and song. You could also search 'Jolly Phonics Learn the letter x' and play this clip a number of times for your child. Encourage them to listen well and join in if you can! I will include the links below.
