

BOM Agreed Report
3rd June 2021

- Sheila O'Donnell was appointed to the BOM as the new community representative.
- Class Allocations will stay the same for next year.
- The BOM was informed that the school was accepted onto cohort 2 of the Sustained School Support for the implementation of the new Primary Language Curriculum. This will involve 3 full day school closures in the 2021/22 school year to facilitate staff training.
- Standardized Test results were presented and approved by the Board.
- The School Calendar for 2021/22 was approved by the Board.
- School Tours will take place on the 22nd of June with 5th & 6th class going to Jamie Knox's Water Sports and all other classes going on Beach Walks on that day. All these events are in line with the recommendations issued to schools from the Dept of Education on the 5th of May.
- 3rd & 4th and 5th & 6th will be going on Cross Country Hikes on the 21st and 23rd respectively.
- First Confession will take place on the 15th of June and the 6th Class Graduation will take place 25th of June. Unfortunately, due to the letter issued to schools on the 5th of May parents are not allowed to attend either event.
- No dates have been decided upon for First Communion and Confirmation this will be reviewed according to Public Health advice.
- The BOM was informed that Kathleen Wallace from Accord gave the RSE talk to 5th and 6th Class on the 27th of May.
- Permission was given by the BOM to run the Summer Provision Program
- The school's SNA and SET allocation are to remain the same for next year.
