- Elana Heasman application to extend her career break for another year was approved by the BOM.
- Denise Hennessy's application to apply for a job share was approved by the BOM.
- The BOM approved the application for an extra class teacher under the Projected Enrolment Post Scheme.
- Permission was granted by the BOM to apply for additional accommodation to accommodate the additional class teacher.
- Permission was granted by the BOM for a full day school closure to take place on Thursday 1st of June to enable staff training the Primary Language Curriculum and the New Primary Curriculum Framework.
- The Open Day for new Junior Infant Pupils will take place on Friday 9th of June.
- The school sports day will take place on the 21st of June.
- Jeremy Walsh Project Management was appointed as the Consultants for the construction of the Old School Car Park.
- Hennebery's Sports was approved by the BOM to be the new supplier of all crests for all school uniforms. Each crest would cost parents €7.50 per crest.
