

BOM Agreed Report

5th March 2024

- The BOM granted permission for Denis Hennessy and Elana Heasman to go on Job Share next year and to be each other's Job Share partner.
- The BOM granted permission for Christina O'Shea to continue her Career Break for the next school year.
- The Revised Parental Complaints Procedure was approved by the BOM.
- The School Accounts for the school year 2022-2023 were approved by the BOM.
- The BOM approved the dates for administration of the standardized tests and the date of Monday 10th of June for the release of the annual school reports to parents.
- The BOM was given an update on the development of an Assessment Policy as part of our SSE.
- Approval was given for the Animal Roadshow to visit the school on Wednesday 19th of June.
- Approval was given for 3rd to 6th class to take part in hikes in Brackloon Annascaul with Tralee Mountaineering Club on Wednesday 19th and Thursday 20th of June and for students to take part in the Cumann na mBunscoil Mini 7's prior to Easter.
- The BOM was informed by the principal that he had met with the PA and they had agreed to fund the visit of the Animal Roadshow, contribute to the cost of school tours for families and contribute to the cost of private bus hire to events.
- The destinations, costs and date for our school tours were approved by the BOM. The Junior School Tour will be to Tralee Bay Wetlands and the Senior Tour will be to UL Activity Centre in Killaloe both on the 17th of June at a cost of €20 for the Junior tour and €50 for the Senior tour.
- The BOM agreed to increase the contribution asked for from parents to cover private bus hire from €2 to €5
- The BOM discussed the progress that has been made with the development of the Car Park.
