

BOM Approved Report

1st July 2025

- The class teachers for each class were approved by the BOM Junior Infants- Senior Infants Gráinne Higgins, 3rd and 4th Mr. Doyle, 2nd Class Ms. Sharon Greaney, the BOM approved the recruitment for the 5th and 6th class teacher and Rachel Sheehy was appointed to the other fixed term contract due to her been given a CID which begins on the 6th of November 2025.
- Approval was given to commence the recruitment process to cover Breda Curran's maternity leave.
- Approval was given for Sharon Greaney to take unpaid maternity leave until the 24th of October.
- The School's Safety Statement, Code of Behaviour and Digital Learning Plan were reviewed.
- Bí Cinealta Anti Bullying Policy, Traffic Management Plan and Irish Policy were all approved by the BOM.
- Approval was given for 5th & 6th class to take part in the Say Yes to Languages Programme for the 2025/26 school year in Term 1.
- The standardised test scores for 2nd, 4th and 6th were examined by the BOM and approved by the BOM.
- The BOM was informed that the SET hours appeal had approved the school for 5 extra SET hours which brings the school's allocation to 48 hrs and by combining this with the 5 hour principal release hours will mean that our second SET teacher will not have to travel to other schools
- The BOM approved annual post of responsibility reports from Ms. Williams and Ms. Hennessy.
- SET Allocations Letter for correct deployment was approved by the BOM
- The BOM was informed that the PA had contributed €3200 to the BOM to pay for new goals, new interactive screens and the cost of buses for the school tours.
- The BOM was informed that Mr. Doyle had a meeting with the school's consultant James Walsh and Stephen O'Sullivan Architect about the positioning of the new classroom and 3 options were considered. Stephen O'Sullivan will examine all options and present his findings to the BOM later in the summer.
- The BOM was informed that an application for planning permission for the school car park had been submitted to Kerry County Council
- Approval was given by the BOM to purchase 4 interactive screens at a total cost of €6,338.98
- The balance in the school's current account was €28,134.74
