

BOM Agreed Report
21st October 2025

- The BOM approved the School Census returns for the 2025-26 school year.
- Denise Hennessy was appointed cover Sharon Greaney's AP2 position while she was on leave.
- Approval was given for Sharon Greaney to take Parental and Parents Leave until 30th of January 2026.
- All EPV Days and Leave was approved for Teaching Staff
- The School's Annual Enrolment Notice was approved.
- The BOM was informed that the school had being accepted onto the sustained support from OIDE for implementing the new Primary Maths Curriculum.
- Approval was given for the school to take part in the Tri Heroes, Cumman na mBunscoil, Ocean Champion Project and for Aaron Moriarty to coach Gaelic Football in the school.
- School Closures for Child Protection Training on 5th November, and teaching staff training in the new Primary Curriculum Framework on the 20th of January and 21st of April 2026 were all approved
- Permission was given for Mr. Doyle to attend Principals Conference on the 26th of September, Trade Union Training on 13th and 14th of October, OIDE professional development on the 4th & 5th of December and the Education Conference on 21st of November.
- Permission was given for Mr. Doyle and Ms. Williams to attend Child Protection Guidelines Training on the 1st of October.
- The BOM was updated on the Cyber Safety Week and the Anti Bullying Week which are part of the School's SSE topic of Wellbeing. Permission was given for Ger Brick to give a talk to 5th and 6th class about internet safety.
- The School's NEPS psychologist conducted an education assessment on Friday 17th of October.
- The school Open Night for new Junior Infants will take place on December 2nd, 2025, at 6:30pm
- The BOM was given an update re the PA AGM and that there had been a secretary and treasurer elected but no chairperson. Mr. Doyle said he would contact parents to gauge interest in taking up the chairperson's role.
- The BOM was updated that the Dept had sanctioned the addition of a new SET room in the building of the new classroom.
- Additional information has been sought from Kerry County Council before granting planning permission for the Old School Car Park.
- Permission was given for the Flu Vaccine to be administered on the 8th of October to children whose parents had consented.
- A fire drill took place on the 24th of September 2025
- The Lunch Bag was approved as the supplier for the hot school meals programme after their tender was scored as the preferred tenderer.
