**9th December 2025**

- The BOM was informed that a successful Open Night was held on 2<sup>nd</sup> of December. 7 children attended with 2 others unable to attend.
- With 9 enrolments that would give projected enrolment of 104 pupils for the next school year.

- RSE Policy and Statement for School Attendance were reviewed by the BOM
