

## BOM Agreed Report

### 17th February 2026

- The Child Safeguarding Statement was reviewed by the BOM.
- Approval was given for Agri Kids to visit the school May 8<sup>th</sup> to speak to all classes about Farm Safety.
- Approval was given for the school part in the Cumann na mBunscoil Cross Country Comp and the FAI 5 a side soccer on the 10<sup>th</sup> of March and 15<sup>th</sup> of April.
- The BOM was briefed about School Self Evaluation and progress with Wellbeing and the upcoming Cyber Safety Week.
- The BOM was informed that all additional information that Kerry County Council has sought had now been submitted to Kerry County Council for the planning application for the Old School Car Park. It is expected that a decision will be made by mid-March.
- The BOM was informed that the Hot School Meal Programme has now started in the school with every child being provided with a hot meal each day for their lunch.
- Approval was given for the Junior School Tour to visit Ballybunion Mini Golf and Cookery School on Wednesday 17<sup>th</sup> of June. The cost of €20 per child was approved.
- The BOM was informed that the next PA meeting will take place on Tuesday 3<sup>rd</sup> of March and Mr. Doyle will again ask the PA to cover the cost of the buses for the school tours.
