

BOM Minutes
12th May 2026

- A meeting of the BOM took place in the school on Tuesday 12th May 2026.
- The BOM was informed that David had spoken to Bus Eireann regarding changing the opening time from 9:30 am to 9:20am and the finish time to 3:00pm and that he was waiting for a response.
- The BOM was informed that there was a projected enrolment of 104 next year in the school and that this was the retention figure for the 5th class teacher.
- Class allocations of juniors and seniors together, 1st class on their own, 2nd class on their own, 3rd & 4th together and 5th & 6th together were approved. Teacher allocations will be approved after recruitment process has been completed
- The BOM was informed that a curriculum evaluation in Irish took place on Monday April 20th and Tuesday April 21st. From oral feedback received by David from the inspectors the standard of Irish teaching in the school was very good.
- Approval was given for the school to run the Summer Programme in the school for 2 weeks from 22nd of June to the 3rd of July
- The BOM thanked Ms Greaney/Ms. Browne for their work in preparing 2nd class for Communion
- Permission was given for 1st to 4th class to take part in a fun football blitz in Castlegregory on Thursday 21st of May, 3rd & 4th class boys to take part in a soccer blitz in the KDL on Wednesday 13th of May.
- The school Sports Day will take place on Thursday 11th of June
- Permission was given for the PA to run a Split the Bucket Competition during the Summer months
- The BOM was informed that full planning permission from Kerry County Council had been granted for the construction of the Old School Car Park
- Permission was given for 5th & 6th class to attend Splash Sport on 9th of June
- The school calendar for the 2026/27 school year was approved by the BOM
